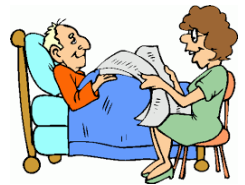

Young at Heart

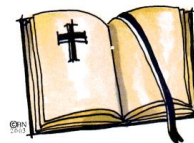
