BOX TOPS FOR EDUCATION




Clipping Box Tops is an easy way for you to help **Good Shepherd Catholic School**. Box Tops are worth 10¢ and they add up to cash


DIOCESE OF ALLENTOWN TO HOST FATIMA STATUE

Feast of Saint Barnabas

Although not one of the Twelve, Barnabas has since ancient times been accorded the title "Apostle" for his labors alongside Paul. After recruiting Paul for the mission to Antioch, the two preached in cities in Asia Minor and in Cyprus. In each town, they began their preaching in the synagogue. They were repeatedly attached and stoned by the Jews – once so severely that Paul almost died. Yet their preaching was not in vain. Returning to Antioch, they "reported what God had done with them and how he had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles" (Acts 14:27). Barnabas was martyred in Cyprus some time before the year 63. *Magnificat, June, 2016*
